This program will be presented by Claudia Frost, a St. Charles Fine Art photographer, educator, and author on Friday, May 2 at the St. Charles Public Library. She will explore photography as an artist's storytelling tool and talk about what makes a well-crafted image.

Essentials of the iPhone/Smartphone camera will be explained in addition to identifying hidden features of the phone camera. She will give compositional suggestions and how to use editing apps to put together unique and creative visuals.

The first half of the presentation will cover the principles of design and art, smart phone camera settings, composition, lighting, adding creative flare, and editing/ processing applications.

The second half will be a hands-on workshop format encouraging participants to try creative ideas.
